

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

- 1. Full payment:** Those making the full payment of registration, book & resource, and tuition by August 1st (or at time of registration if after August 1st) will receive a 5% discount on the tuition amount. (\$0 FACTS participation fee)
- 2. Semi-annual payments** will receive a 2.5% discount. Payments will be through FACTS with payment 1 on July or August 1 and payment 2 on January 1. (\$10 FACTS participation fee)
- 3. 10 monthly payments** drafted from your bank account through FACTS. Tuition payments begin July 5th or 20th and finish with the last payment due on April 5th or 20th. (\$45 FACTS participation fee)
- 3. 12 monthly payments** drafted from your bank account through FACTS. This is available for those who register by April 1st. Fees and tuition will be included and divided by 12 equal payments to begin May 5th. (\$45 FACTS participation fee)
4. If registration occurs after July 15th, the first month's tuition, along with registration and book and resource fee is due prior to beginning class. If registering after August 15th, the annual tuition will be prorated with the last payment being received no later than May 5th.

BEFORE CARE & AFTER CARE

As a service to working parents, the academy offers Before Care and After Care. Before Care is available from 7:30 a.m. until 8:15 a.m. After Care is available from 3:25 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. Children who arrive at school prior to 8:15 a.m. **MUST** go to the Before Care room. **\$6 per hour (or any part thereof) is charged for Before Care and/or After Care.**

Before Care & After Care is included in the cost of tuition for full day K3 & K4 Students.

Parents of students needing Before Care and/or After Care on a regular basis **MUST complete a Request for Before Care and After Care** form in order to have this service available. Any change in the schedule requires a two week notice in writing. A rare emergency may be arranged by contacting the academy administration.

A charge of \$10 per 10 minutes will be incurred for those who pick up students after 6:00 p.m. This charge will be billed and due to be paid by the 10th of each month.

PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR BEFORE CARE AND AFTER CARE:

1. Payment in full for the year paid at the beginning of the year (no discount.)
2. Monthly drafts from your bank account to be made with the FACTS payment. Must be approved by the office.
3. Billed by the office with prior approval and space available in before care/after care. (This option is only for those who occasionally use these services.)

FINANCIAL POLICIES

SCBA seeks to keep its fees and tuition as low as possible. However, the fees and tuition are the academy's only source of planned income. Therefore it is necessary that all accounts be kept up-to-date. SCBA cannot carry delinquent accounts. Accounts which become delinquent must be paid before students may continue in class. There is a \$30 charge on all FACTS denials or returned checks.

For those families living in Mecklenburg county, you may be interested in learning about the Children's Scholarship Fund. For those families living in North Carolina (not just Mecklenburg county), you may be interested in learning about the Opportunity Scholarship Grant. Information about both of these programs may be found at scbacademy.org/financialaid.

Parents who have a returned check or insufficient funds in FACTS must bring in a cashier's check, money order, or cash along with \$30 for the insufficient charges, for the missed payment, within two days of the denial.

The **REGISTRATION FEE** is due at the time of registration and is non-refundable. This fee holds student's seat until July 1st. After July 1st the student may lose their seat if 1) the enrollment has not been completed and 2) the class is full.

The **BOOK AND RESOURCE FEE** is non-refundable and due by June 1st or at the time of enrollment if later than July 1st. This fee covers such things as textbooks, RenWeb access, standardized testing materials, graduation regalia, other classroom supplies, and craft/art supplies.

The Administration reserves the right to withhold any refunds for tuition or fees upon withdrawal (See Withdrawal Procedures).
